Year 12 Applications

Applications are assessed on a personal statement, a copy of the student's most recent school report, mock or predicted grades, an interview with a member of the Sixth Form team and a supporting reference from the student's current school.

All required documents should be sent to the Admissions Department by email to admissions@newhallschool.co.uk, or can be submitted with the Sixth Form Scholarship Application Form.

Our entry requirements to Sixth Form are a minimum of three grade 7s and two grade 6s at GCSE, although certain subjects do carry individual grade requirements. Entry onto the BTEC Diploma in Sport requires a proven record of participation in sport, a minimum of a grade 5 in an essay-based subject at GCSE and students will also be required to meet the subject-specific criteria for the A Level subject which they wish to take alongside the BTEC.

Scholarship & Award Applications

New Hall School offers scholarships and awards at Sixth Form entry. Preference may be given to boarders and to Catholic applicants, where candidates of a similar ability are being considered for scholarships. The School celebrates the honour of all scholarship achievements and students who win scholarships gain an important benefit in terms of public recognition, university/apprenticeship/job applications and references. Scholars are afforded additional target setting, monitoring and reporting.
